Notes to Exhibitors

A separate entry blank must be completed for each dog entered. ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED!!

Bitches in season will be permitted to run but will be moved to the end of the running order. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Test arena.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, extreme weather conditions, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.

Please keep your dogs on leash at ALL times and PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG!!

EMERGENCY & DISASTER PROCEDURES

FIRE/ POLICE/ AMBULANCE / MEDICAL EMERGENCIES – DIAL 911

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs.
